One of Europe's most stunning Baroque landmarks, this ensemble – comprising the Upper and Lower Belvedere and an extensive garden – is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Today the Belvedere houses the greatest collection of Austrian art dating from the Middle Ages to the present day, complemented by the work of international artists. Highlights from the holdings Vienna 1880–1914 are the world's largest collection of Gustav Klimt's paintings (including the famous golden Art Nouveau icons the Kiss (Lovers) and Judith) and works by Egon Schiele and Oskar Kokoschka.

WORKSHOPS

Vienna Gold

The focus of this tour is Gustav Klimt's golden paintings, a wonderful source of inspiration for crafting your very own souvenir using delicate gold leaf.

AUDIOGUIDES

Audio guides with commentaries about key works in the collection and information about the Belvedere Palace are available in German, English, French, Italian, Spanish, Japanese, Korean and Russian. There is also a multimedia tour in Austrian sign language.

For the temporary exhibitions there are audio-guide tours in German and English.
